All Schools are expected to supply personnel to referee and mark squads.

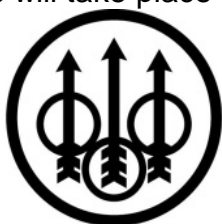
**AMMUNITION:** May be purchased on grounds, on presentation of a Firearms Licence.
