

Explanatory Notes – Skeet

- The Hall of Fame Committee recommended that people earning 100 points and 3 National titles prior to 2003 be admitted on the basis that prior to 2003 there was only 12 Gauge events, and there was no standalone National Skeet tournament.
- As of 2018; 150 points for admission was considered reasonable given the opportunities that shooters had to gain points.
- It was decided that the opportunity to earn points had increased in recent years due to the standalone Island events and the introductions of sub gauge events as National titles therefore it was concluded that the 150 point threshold should be raised each calendar year until 200 points was reached.
- Future changes to qualification can be made by the NZCTA Council in consultation with the Skeet Subcommittee.
- It is possible to be inducted into the Hall of Fame and be recognised for more than one discipline i.e. a shooter may have qualified in DTL, Skeet, Sporting and ISSF if they have achieved the level of points in each discipline.
