Welcome from the Waikato Clay Target Club

On behalf of the Waikato Clay Target Club, Kia ora, Tēnā koutou, haere mai, welcome to all competitors, supporters and spectators to the North Island and New Zealand Secondary School Nationals for 2021.

Please be considerate of our grounds and dispose of used shells and other rubbish in the bins provided. These will be emptied daily and we appreciate your support in keeping the grounds tidy and litter free.

Squads - Please ensure that the correct score sheet is used prior to the commencement of shooting with the school name and the correct shooters on the sheet and remember to check scores prior to leaving the stand.

Referees and Scorers - Schools need to provide both a referee and scorer to score the following squad.

- Check school name and the correct shooters on the sheet.
- Call hits and misses loud enough so that the shooter can hear.
- Ensure that the shooters check their scores prior to leaving the mark.
- *No first year shooters to be used as referees or scorers please.*

Practice Trap – Requires \$2 coins (5 targets). Coins will be available for exchange at the ammunition shed for the designated practice trap.

Ammunition – Can be purchased at the bar or ammunition window on the side of the building.

Gun safety on the grounds– Please ensure no firearms are brought into the club house, a firearms licence holder must be actively supervising all students when using, transporting or storing their firearm. At all time firearms must be under the supervision of a licence holder or stored securely. Where firearms are stored in vehicles between events, the vehicles must be locked to ensure firearms are safe and secure. Following the changes in gun laws, this rule must be adhered to and will be enforced by the club. Firearms may be moved to a secure location by Waikato Club officials if they have sufficient concerns that guns have been left unsecured and unattended. Firearms can be stored at the end of each day in the Waikato Club armoury.

Shoot-offs – Will be at the end of each days shooting in the following order. Points Score, Single Barrel and Single Rise

Jury/Shooters Representatives - A three-person jury and shooters representatives will be present at the event and available to resolve any issues that arise during the shooting – representatives names will be posted on the noticeboard.

Safety and Etiquette

Shooting will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the NZCTA. Competitors, Coaches and Managers are expected to be familiar with all NZCTA safety rules. These can be found on the NZCTA website or alternatively please contact the National Office for a hard copy.

All competitors are expected to be proficient in the handling of shotguns and familiar with the conducting of their respective events including scoring. NZCTA rules require competitors to have recorded in their handicap book, a minimum of 3 scores for DTL, which have been shot at three separate competitions, and a minimum of 3 competition rounds of skeet, which have been shot at three separate competitions (if they are entering the Island and National skeet events).

All shooters who do not hold current firearm licenses must be supervised by appropriately licensed individuals while on the mark or in possession of firearms, including:

1. The carrying of firearms to and from vehicles.
2. Storing of firearms in vehicles.
3. Transportation of firearms to and from Club grounds.

We would also ask parents, coaches and managers to support the referees and scorers during the competitions for if, and when a dispute arises it can be dealt with swiftly and with the least amount of bother. Remember good safety habits and good behaviour makes for a great competition.

- For DTL there is a Junior grade (year 9 and 10) for events (includes both boys and girls). The Seniors (year 11-13) will compete as per usual. Juniors will be eligible for HOA

All competitors must bring a signed letter from the principal of their school attesting to their eligibility to represent the school at this event. Any students without this permission will not be permitted to compete

Things You Need To Know

This event is run entirely by volunteers for your benefit. We ask you and your supporters to please treat these people with courtesy and respect as they have given up their time for you, and without them this event would not exist.

It is the competitor's responsibility to be on the correct field at the right time with the necessary equipment to compete, remember to bring sufficient ammunition.

Competitors please remember to check your scores at the end of the match before leaving the field. Referees and Scorers should remain at the field until all scores have been checked. If you do not agree with the score this needs to be queried with the referee at the time as once you leave the field your results cannot be challenged. If you disagree with your score and cannot resolve it, remain at the field and ask someone to find the shooters representative.

If you are refereeing or scoring a match you must remain at the field until all competitors have checked their scores in case of a dispute.

The Referee has absolute say on scoring decisions. No interference from spectators is allowed.

Coaching on the mark is not allowed.

Long runs can be applied for, for Skeet and for DTL (all targets shot under Single Rise and Points Score count), for 50, 75, 100, 200, 300 targets. A student long run of 25 can be applied for the first time this is achieved.

As a secondary school event this competition is drug, alcohol and smoke free. Safety is a high priority in our sport; this rule must be strictly adhered to.

KEY THINGS TO REMEMBER –

- All staff are volunteers – be polite and courteous.
- Be at your allocated field with all required equipment in plenty of time.
- Check your scores before leaving the field.
- This competition is drug, alcohol and smoke free.
- Most importantly handle your gun safely and remember they must be stored either in a locked vehicle or the club armoury when not in use.

Reminder of Rule Change

Competitors must have a minimum of 3 scores recorded in their handicap book for DTL, and for Skeet if shooting that event, which have been shot at three separate competitions.

Team Selections

Points Score Teams

Five person and 3-person teams from the same school, shot over the points score event. The 5-person team is an Open team, usually made up of 5 boys but the rules allow for up to 2 girls to be in the team. The 3-person team is a girls-only team.

Skeet Teams

Two person teams from the same school. The Open teams may be made up of 2 boys, 2 girls, or 1 boy and 1 girl and have placings 1st to 3rd. There is also a 1st placing for a 2-person Girls Team.

North vs South Teams

This is a 15tgt Points Score event. The Open teams will be the top five shooters from each Island selected from the NZ Points Score and NZ Single Rise aggregate scores (a total of 80 points). In the event of a tie for placings in the team a shoot-off over multiples of 5 points score will be conducted until the tie is broken. The Ladies teams are the top three ladies from each Island under the same criteria.

Fish & Game Regional Teams

This is a team event between Fish & Game regions (as opposed to provinces). Limited to one open team (5 shooters, maximum of 2 ladies) and one ladies team (3 shooters) from each region. Shooters are deemed to be in the region that their School is located in. Where a region is not able to field a full team, individuals may compete for the individual titles. The event is shot as 30 tgt Triples off 18 metres.

Teams are selected over the highest scores from the two days of the Island and NZ DTL Championships on a first past the post system from those who will be available to compete in the event on the Monday morning. Regions are responsible for selecting their teams. Entries must be in at the end of Sunday. The vision for the event is to include a representative from all schools in every Fish & Game Region in NZ.

Opportunities to Shoot

As a registered member of the NZ Clay Target Association you can participate in the sport at open level outside of the school shooting circuit. Attending events at your own club will improve your shooting, give you more experience at competition events, involve you in your club and in turn support them for the time and assistance they give to you. Outside of your own club there are shoots held every weekend throughout NZ, these events range from small club shoots through to national championships. If you would like to pursue the sport further, your coach and/or club can advise you on which shoots would be appropriate.
