Mr Duncan Fraser

1864 – 1939

Mr Duncan Fraser 1st Hall of Fame inductee.

Duncan Fraser married Margaret McLeod in 1892; they had a son Donald Fraser. Donald was the National Champion 1910 Live Sparrow (at age 16) beating his father into second place!

Duncan and Donald were both associated with the Te Kuiti Gun Club.

Duncan held world record in live pigeon shooting 59 from 60 birds, from 33 yards

Duncan Fraser was also a C.A.C representative.

Duncan Fraser competed in Australia in 1906 at NSW Gun club.

- First person to shoot 200 straight in skeet one match (216 with RW Gunn)
- 20 plus times in Mackintosh Team, 2 x Mackintosh High Gun.
- Only NZ competitor to win the NZ Single Barrel back to back.

John was married, Mary, they had 4 children Lyndsey, Darryl, Brian and Neil.

Dick Arnst was an extremely talented sports person with origins in Christchurch, NZ. Dick was an exceptional cyclist 1903 he competed Sydney to Wornabool road race finishing fifth, his cycling career culminating in 1906 winning the "Sydney 1000" the richest road race in the world at that time.

1908 Dick took up Sculling he became World Champion and held that title 1908, 1909, 1910, 1911, 1912 and again 1921 and 1922. These races were held in NZ and Australia except 1910 was on the Zambesi River South Africa.

Dick took up trapshooting after his Sculling career came to an end.

Richard Arnst was inducted into The NZ Sports Hall of Fame in 1995.
