NOTES

There is a \$10.00 optional sweep on all championships (ungraded)

All sweeps are paid out (in full) 50%, 35%, 15%.

Grade placings are paid out 1st 50%, 2nd 35%, 3rd 15%.

At Island Provincial and Zone events for DTL, Skeet and ISSF a Lady, Junior, or Veteran may enter the category only. The entry fee is \$5 plus targets per event (\$4 to conducting club \$1 to NZCTA) There would be no sweeps or grade prizes.

Two and five shooter Skeet teams. These are conducted at all Assn Skeet Championship events. Entry fee is: National Champs \$5 per shooter, Island Champs \$4 per shooter, Provincial Champs \$3 per shooter. The host club deducts 10% from each pool and pays out the rest, 75% winning team, 25% second place.

An <u>additional</u> \$3.00 per person per day, travel levy will be added to all NZCTA Zone, Island and National Championships for Sporting and Compak as well as any other Oceania Qualifying events eg Waikato Mid Winter or Rotorua Presidents Cup. Please identify this separately on your return.

The \$4 Daily levies are not charged at Provincial, Zone, Island and National Championships. This is included in the championship entry fee.
