

RULES AND SHOOTING ETIQUETTE

1. Please be ready to shoot (with sufficient ammo) at your assigned trap **BEFORE** the previous squad is finished.
2. The shooters feet must remain within the confines of the lane (not forward or aft of the mark)
3. A shooter must remain on the lane until the next shooter has finished shooting
4. Ammunition must be removed from the firearm when moving from Lane 5 to Lane 1
5. **In the case of firearm malfunction.** Keep the firearm facing toward the trap house and await the referee instruction
6. Shooters must remain on the mark until all other shooters in the squad have finished shooting
7. Please remain quiet until it is your turn to shoot
8. A shooter must call the target within 10 seconds of the previous shooters last shot

SAFETY RULES

1. Eye protection is compulsory. without exceptions, for all shooters, referees, staff and anyone else in the immediate vicinity of a stand. Any shooter on a stand not wearing safety glasses is considered absent.
2. Fully closed footwear must be worn while shooting (no jandals or sandals)
3. Hearing protection is compulsory for all shooters, referees, staff and members of the public on or in proximity of a layout. Any shooter on a stand without hearing protection is considered absent. In all circumstances outside the clubhouse, scildren present on a range must wear hearing protection.
4. No firearm is to be left unattended on the the Club grounds
5. All shooters must hold a current Firearms Licence (or supervised by someone who does), and be able to produce the licence on request
6. All firearms must be moved around the grounds in the open state. Automatic weapons must have the breech open.
7. No steel shot to be used
