Before entering, please read the details on the entry process and refund policies. Your entry as a competitor and payment of the entry fee is confirmation that you acknowledge the terms of entry and that you will abide by the rules and regulations of the NZCTA, the CCTA and the ICTSF.

To secure your competitor position, your entry fee must be paid by online banking at the time of completing your online entry.

Competitor entries will be received and prioritised in chronological order of receipt of entry fee by the Canterbury Clay Target Club (CCTC).

In the event the competitor field is oversubscribed, then a waitlist will be created, again, in chronological order of receipt of the competitor's entry fee.

2. 2026 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITOR FIELD

On 4 July 2025, 270 competitor places for the 2026 World DTL Championship will be released.

Entries will be received and prioritised in the chronological order of the receipt of entry fees by the CCTC.

If the competitor field is oversubscribed, a waitlist will be created. The order on the waitlist will again be determined according to the chronological order of the receipt of entry fees by the CCTC.

In addition to the 270 released competitor spaces, approximately 150 competitor places will be reserved for team members from the ICTSF-affiliated countries. These team positions must be confirmed by the respective ICTSF country associations no later than **Sunday 30th November 2025**.

CCTC recognise that after the team entries are received and allocated, competition spaces may become available for allocation to waitlist competitors. For example:

- There may be less than 150 team entries received: or
- There may be individual entries within the initial release of 270 competitors whom are successful in making team selection for their country after submitting their entry.

As competitor places become available, and subject always to the payment of the competitor's entry fee, and the maximum competitor field of 420 competitors, those on the competitor waitlist will be notified by email if their entry has been moved from the waitlist to a guaranteed placement in the competitor field.

Fully paid entries on the waitlist can be withdrawn at any time without penalty, and a full refund will be issued, provided that the CCTC has not yet notified the competitor that their entry has been moved from the waitlist to the confirmed competitor field.

3. ONLINE ENTRY

Once the form is completed and submitted, you will receive an e-mail detailing the requirements for the payment of your entry fee.

Confirmation of your entry as a competitor is contingent upon full payment of your entry fee being received by the CCTC.

4. ENTRY FEE:

The 2026 World Championship Entry Fee is NZ\$485.00

The full entry fee of NZ\$485.00. is payable by bank transfer only. We are unable to accept payment with a credit card.

After completing the online competitor entry form via the hyperlink, you will be emailed the payment requirements for your entry fee.

Please ensure that when you make your online payment, you include:

- Your federation membership number in the particulars field;
- Your surname in the reference field;
- Your full payment of NZ\$485.00.

Confirmation of your entry as a competitor for this event is contingent upon full payment of your entry fee being received by the CCTC. International visitors will have 14 days to make payment from the time of their entry being submitted.

5. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:

By completing your competitor entry and paying your entry fee, you acknowledge the terms of your entry as a competitor at the 2026 ICTSF World DTL Championships. Those terms of entry include the following cancellation terms:

If, after making payment of your entry fee you give notice in writing to CCTC of your desire to cancel your entry, then:

- If your cancellation notice is received prior to the 14th of January 2026, CCTC will refund 85% of your entry fee and the remaining 15% will be retained by CCTC as a cancellation and administration fee:
- After the 14th of January 2026, your entry fee is non-refundable:
- If you have paid your entry fee but you are on the waitlist and have not received notification from CCTC of a confirmed competitor position, then you may give notice in writing of cancellation of your entry and your entry fee will be refunded to you in full.
- If a competitor withdraws their entry after 14 January 2026 and requests that the refund of their entry should be considered due to exceptional circumstances, then the CCTC in consultation with the NZCTA, will consider those requests on a caseby-case basis. The CCTC, in consultation with the NZCTA, reserves the right to determine whether a refund of an entry fee should be completed.

Any approved refunds will be paid by bank transfer to the competitor's nominated bank account within ten days of cancellation.

6. KEY DATES:

4 July 2025, 12 noon:

Online registrations open for individual entries (270 spaces available).

30 November 2025:

Team entries close for ICTSF member countries (150 reserved spaces for these team members).

30 November 2025:

Unpaid competitor entries will be moved to a competitor waitlist.

1 December 2025 onwards:

Waitlist competitors will be notified if a competitor space is available for them to enter as a competitor.

15 March 2026:

2026 ICTSF DTL World Championship competition commences
